

Unreal Past

RULE#1 => WISH + PAST SIMPLE is used to express regrets or wishes about the present (or future)

She wishes she had a holiday now.

RULE#2 => WISH + PAST CONTINUOUS is used to express that we want to be doing a different action in the present (or future).

I wish she wasn't leaving right now.

RULE#3 => IF ONLY + PAST PERFECT is used to express regrets or wishes about the past.

If only George hadn't sold all these old CD's last year.

RULE#4 => WISH + COULD = regret in the present concerning lack of ability in the future.

I wish Graham could see the children now.

RULE#5 => WISH + WOULD is used to express annoyance, impatience or dissatisfaction with a present action.

I wish it would stop raining tomorrow.

If

If you came to the party you might get to meet Sue. I know you want to meet her.

If I had the time I would take you out to dinner. However, I am too busy.

If only

We use 'if only' for regrets. When we regret having done something. Look at these examples:

If only I had taken the job at the bank. I regret not taking the job.

If only I were more handsome.

It's time

By the way, it's time we had a chat about your future in this company.

It's very late. **It's time he went** to bed.

It's time you got a job because I am sick and tired of paying for everything.

Wish

I wish we weren't all going to lose our jobs.

She wishes her husband would spend more time with the family. As a result, she might get a divorce.

I wish I didn't have to give a speech tomorrow.

Would rather, would sooner

I'd rather you didn't go to the party alone.

I don't want you here. **I'd sooner you left** the room.
